# Workshop on Electricity Market Monitoring in South East Europe

## Introducing the South East Europe Automated Market Monitoring System

### Objectives

To advance the development of electricity market monitoring in South East Europe, the Energy Community Regulatory Board (ECRB) Electricity Working Group (EWG) invited USAID to develop an automated market monitoring system to implement the various market monitoring screens that have been developed through the Dry-Run Market Monitoring Project. The South East Europe Automated Market Monitoring System (SEEAMMS) allows upload and storage of market monitoring data and the production of screen results and reports.

The goals of the Workshop are:

- To review the screens, thresholds, and processes proposed in the Market Monitoring Guidelines;
- Demonstrate how the SEEAMMS will function;
- Allow work shop participants to operate the system;

The desired outcomes of the workshop are:

- To achieve TSO/NRA understanding of SEEAMMS;
- Facilitate recommendations for SEEAMMS implementation.
